Beginning his politics with undivided NCP led by Sharad Pawar, the heir from the royal family has been a low profile leader restricting his work to Satara in western Maharashtra. A decendent of great warrior king Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj, Bhosale is also the cousin of Udayan Raje Bhosale — BJP's Satara Lok Sabha MP, also belonging to the royal clan.
