Nisith faces heat in old murder-bid case

Minister's bail plea shot down

patory bail petition as he was named in connection with an attempt-to-murder case reg-istered with Dinhata police station of Cooch Behar. The

station of Cooch Behar. The police have an arrest warrant in his name.

Sources said that in 2018, ahead of the rural polls, a person was shot at and suffered a bullet wound. Pramanik, then with Trinamul, was named in the case.

"The police recovered the bullet. That is why sections of the Arms Act were also included in the case. An arrest warrant is pending in Nisith Pramanik's name and police can execute the warrant till May this year," said Aditi Shankar Chakraborty, the government lawyer

The division bench comprising Justice Surya Prakash Kesarwani and Justice Rai Chattopadhyay heard the case at the Jalpaiguri circuit bench on Thursday.

"In the course of the hear-ing, we mentioned that sever-al cases are pending against Nisith Pramanik. After hear-ing us, the division bench refused to grant him antici-patory ball. The case will be heard again on January 22." Chakraborty added. In 2018, ahead of the rural polls, when Pramanik was

Pramanik had defied the district leadership and fielded several dissidents. Many of them emerged winners. This triggered political violence between Trinamul factions before and after the polls. Pramanik joined the BJP in February 2019. He contested the Lok Sabha polls the same year and won the Cooch Behar seat. He later became a junior Union minister.

Several Trinamul lead-ers on Thursday said that the Union minister-should face legal consequences because of his alleged role in the case.

"Criminal cases are pend-ing against him (Praman-ik). He was even named in the murder case of a former

panchayat member of our party in 2018, ahead of rural polls. We believe the police will take appropriate steps and will take appropriate steps and bring him to book. The Lok Sabha polls are nearing. We suspect he may try to foment tension to garner support," said Rabindranath Ghosh, a

said Rabindranath Ghosh, a Trinamul state vice-president. BJP leaders said Trinamul had implicated Pramank in the case with political intent. "Many leaders and work-ers of our party have been falsely named in police cases in Bengal. This is yet anoth-er instance. We will legally contest the case and political-ly counter Trinamul," said Sukanta Majumdar, the Ben-gal BJP chief.

Hike in Bengal's jute wages after pact

ment on Wednesday raised the minimum daily wage of jute labourers at the entry level to Rs 485 from the existing Rs 370 and offered multiple financial benefits by signing a tripartite agreement with the jute industry representatives and labour

The tripartite agreement. The tripartite agreement, to improve the wages and other financial benefits of some three lash jute workers in Bengal, would come into effect from February 4, 2024, state labour welfare minister Moloy Ghatak said on Thursday. The pact will be effective for the next three years.

The last such pact was simed in 2021.

The last such pact was signed in 2019.
The revision in the jute industry wages comes ahead of a scheduled visit by Union textile minister Plyush Goyal to Calcutta later this week. Industry sources said the Union minister was expected to take stock of the developments in the jute sector, including concerns such as falling raw jute prices.

After the previous agreement expired in early 2023, labour unions sought from the state government a wage hike and other benefits.

According to the pact, a worker would draw a gross monthly wage of Rs 14,066 at the entry level, which is a hike of about Rs 3,562 a month. A senior labouter would draw a grossly monthly wage of Rs 17,271, Rs 553 more than his previous wage. Employees hired in 2020 will draw a month of Rs 62, for Rs 15,357, and 15,357, and month rs 62, for Rs 15,357, and a local month of Rs 62, for a 15,357, and however, all existing labourers will get a one-time ad hoc amount of Rs 130 per month, which will be added to the basic wages, apart from DA.

The industry representatives unanimously agreed to hike house rent al-lowance to 7.5 per cent from 5

per cent.

Among the other major benefits, a new worker will be paid an attendance incentive of Rs 20 daily for at least 12 out of Rs 20 daily for at least 12 out of 15 days of uninterrupted attendance. Also, labourers working for 20 or more years will be made "permanent", which stands to benefit around

one lakh workers.

Representatives of the Indian Jute Mills Association (IMJA), 113 individual jute mill owners not associated with the IMJA, and 23 labour unions, along with INTTUC, signed the pact in Ghatak's presence.

The IMJA welcomed the pact but also pointed out the added expense with the wage hike.

e. "The new wage agree-"The new wage agree-ment comes into effect from February 4. We anticipate a 5 per cent rise in wage bils because of it. It will raise op-erating costs and we have to see how best to manage at a time when there are demand constraints," Raghavendra Gupta, the IMJA chairperson told The Telegraph. "But we are committed to worker wel-fare."

Labour department of-ficials said jute mill owners agreed to divide workers into unskilled, semi-skilled, skilled and highly skilled categories.
