They are also demanding that no action be taken against any student who took part in the protests. Buker was 'under stress' owing to multiple backlogs and his repeated pleas to held special examinations to clear the backlogs were 'not' accepted, the students claimed.

A senior member of the administration had met the students on Monday night and on Tuesday afternoon, requesting them to call off the protect till the director returns on Friday but the students students dented to their demands in the absence of written assurance to meet them. Senior officers of the cen-tral investigating agency said Majlti had been directed to appear before a team of inter-

The case of money laundering stems from an FIR registered by the CBI in November 2020, alleging a multi-crore-rupee coal pillerage scam related to Eastern Coalfields Limited mines at Kumstoria and Kajora in Bengal. Majhi is a resident of Purulia district. The ED had summoned him several times in the past but he has evaded the questioning.

HC: Kurmi rail blockades illegal

Calcutta: Calcutta High Court

Calcuttar Calcutta High Court on Tuesday declared as illegal the call for indefinite rail and road blockades from Wednesday by a few outfits of the Kurmi community.

A few Kurmi organisations in Bengal and Jharkhand had called for indefinite blockades from Wednesday to press for the community's demand for Scheduled Tribe (ST) satus.

While a division bench headed by Chief Justice T.S. Sivagnanam passed the interim order following a public interest litigation (PIL), the Adivasi Kurmi Samaj decided to call off the agitation in the

Advars Rurmi Samaj decided to call off the agitation in the face of "pressure from the state machinery". Aljit Mahato, the chief advisor to the Adivasi Kurmi Samaj, which is the prime outfit that gave the call for the agitation, said on Tuesday. "We have decided to withdraw the proposed blockade in Bengal because of tremendous pressure from the state machinery and police. The police arrested over a dozen of our leaders from various districts in false cases to stop our peaceful movement. Our members will join the protest

our peaceful movement. Our members will join the protest in Jharkhand."

A source in the court said:
"The bench asked central and state governments to take all possible steps to ensure that

normality was not disturbed following the agitation. The day's interim order was issued by the court in the light of an order of the apex court of the country that banned such road and rail blockades in the early 1905."

Durgapur: A fire broke out at the head-

quarters of the Asansol-Durgapur De-velopment Authority (ADDA) here early on Tuesday, triggering an apprehension that important documents related to land, tenders and development projects

were charred. The ADDA is a nodal agency of the Bengal government to implement development projects and the authorised lessor of commercial and domestic plots in its 1,600sq km area of operation in West Burdwan.

Burdwan.
Altogether, 12 firefighting engines of the fire brigade, SAIL, Damodar Valley Corporation (DVC) and Kazi Nazul Islam Airport at nearby Andla were pressed into service and took almost eight hours to douse the blaze that broke out at 2am. One firefigher fell sick during the open from and was hospitalised.
A preliminary report of the fire

department said a short-circuit had caused the blaze. ADDA chairman and Trinamul Congress MLA Tapas Baner-jee has ordered a forensic probe into the incident. incident.
Sources said the fire had broken out on the second floor of the three-storey building, where the ADDA office is lo-



gutted.

The flames did not reach two natio alised banks and two state-run cooper ative banks located on the ground floo of the building. The first floor was not effected either.

affected either.
While ADDA officials said it was an accidental fire, Opposition parties saw it as an attempt to destroy "evidence" of ras an attempt to destroy evidence corruption.

"We have been receiving informs of malpractices in the commercial la distribution of the ADDA. The fire n

distribution of the ADDA. The fire may be a sabotage to destroy evidence," said Lakkhan Ghorul, local BJP MLA. However, ADDA chairman Banerjee said: "All duplicate copies of documents are safe in our office in Assassol. The documents can be found online also, on main server rorm was safe. The Opposition parties are trying to politicise an accident."
